

TYPES OF TRIPS

Policy and Procedures

Flying trips: the group will gather a designated meeting place inside the Minneapolis/St Paul airport (MSP); travelers will be notified of the meeting place well in advance of the trip.

Participants not flying out of MSP, must make their own arrangements (or have his/her guardian or care provider do so) for any assistance needed at their home airport, before and after the trip, and at a layover airport as needed. Fees may apply, for travel not originating from MSP.

All participants must have a valid ID in order to fly.

Driving trips: all trips will leave from Hammer Residences in Wayzata, MN. Participants, their guardians or care providers are responsible for transportation to and from Hammer before and after the trip. Airport assistance can be arranged for people flying in for the trip (fees may apply). Any necessary arrangements for accompaniment from gate to gate, before and after the trip must be made ahead of time by the participant or his/her guardian or care provider.

Cruises/International Travel: Participants must have a valid passport in order to board a cruise ship or leave the country. Cruise vacations may require arriving at the destination city a day earlier than the cruise departure day to ensure that we arrive at the dock on time. The policy for flying also pertains to cruise and international vacations.
